



## *Rolling Respect*

**Time Needed:** 20 Min

**Materials Needed:**

- Rolling Respect Game Sheet (Below)

### **Procedures:**

1. Have a discussion with students about what respect means.
2. Get their ideas first and then if they haven't stated it already explain that respect is all about showing others we value them as people.
  - o We respect others through our actions and our words.
  - o We treat them with kindness even if we do not know them, we are polite and use manners and we listen when others talk.
  - o We acknowledge that we all look different, think different, celebrate differently, have different beliefs, come from different families and backgrounds, learn different and we know that we all deserve the right to be treated fairly.
  - o Respect is how we show others that even though we are different, we are all special.
  - o We care enough to think about someone else's feelings before we do or say something.
  - o When we understand each other, and celebrate each other because of our differences we are showing each other respect; we are showing we care and value others.
3. Amelia wants all students to be respectful in their words and actions. Talk about how respect is a crucial part of Anti-Bullying & Acceptance. When we show respect to others, there is no bullying.
4. Using the Rolling Respect Game, (if virtual - share your screen with your students so they can all see what each roll of the die means), have students take turns rolling a die and having them complete the corresponding sentence. (You can roll a virtual die here: <https://www.random.org/dice/> or here: <https://rolladie.net/>)

Alternate Option: You can put the class in teams and have them play in their small teams, allowing them to roll their own die.

### **Discussion Questions:**

1. What do you think respect has to do with Anti-Bullying and Acceptance?
2. What did you learn about your classmates during this activity?
3. What is one way you are going to work on to be more respectful?

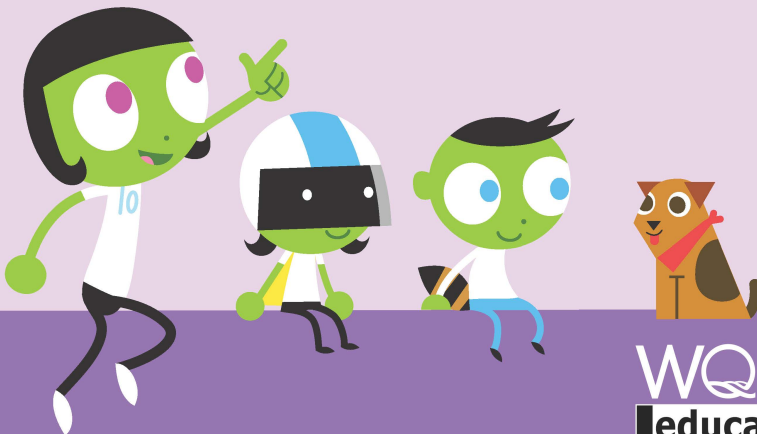
